


Students can print to the campus printers on a variety of BYOD devices.

Step 1: On their device, browse to <https://printers.up.education/>

Step 2: They have two set up options. **Basic** and **Auto Managed** printing. Basic is the most common type of printer set up for BYOD devices. If the user wants to print from a mobile phone, Chromebook or doesn't need finishing options like stapling & hole punching, then use the **Basic** option. If the user needs finishing options and is printing from a Windows or MacOS device, then they should choose **Auto Managed**.

BYOD Printing



Basic:	This is suitable for the majority of printing. This allows for basic printing options with no finishing e.g. stapling, hole punching etc..
Auto Managed:	This enables advanced features like stapling, booklet making etc.. but requires an application installed onto your device.
Yoobee Design:	If you are a Yoobee Student that requires RIP access, please install this driver first, then follow the Auto Managed Process
